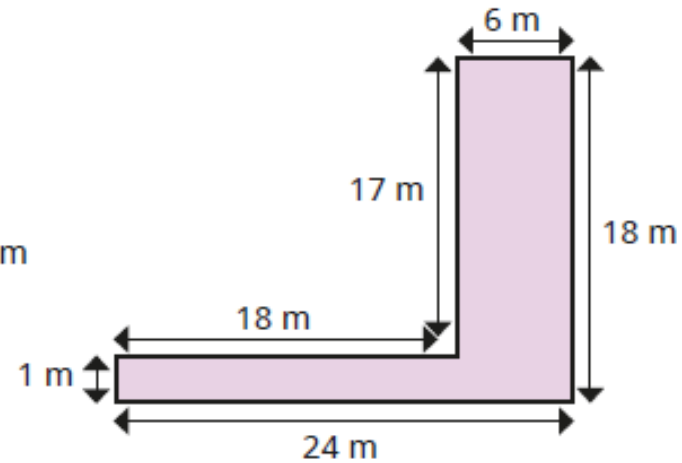
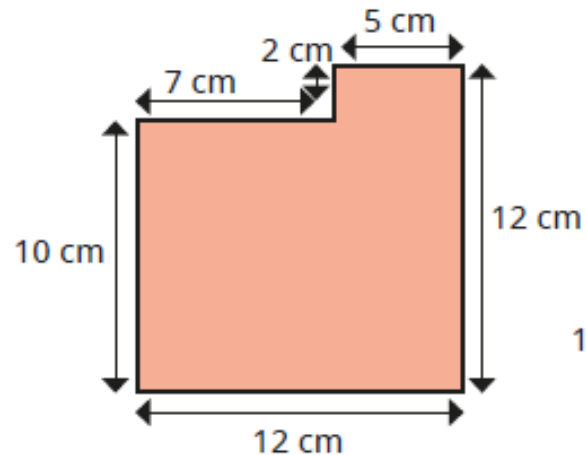
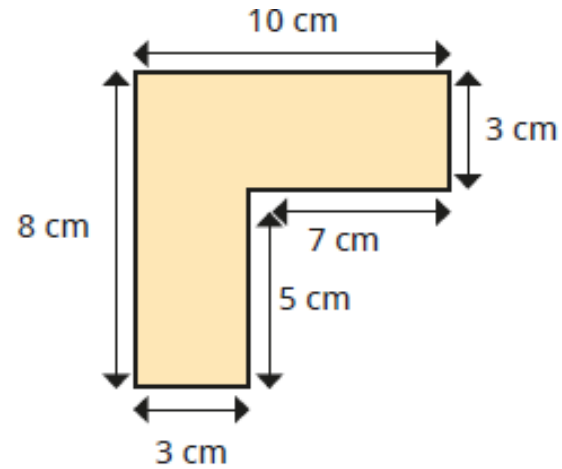
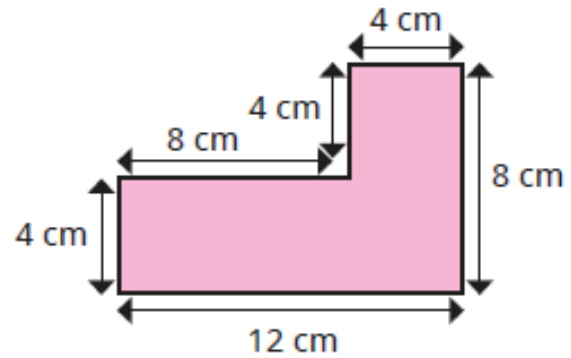
Perimeter is the total distance around the outside of a 2D shape.



$$5 + 5 + 4 + 4 = 18$$

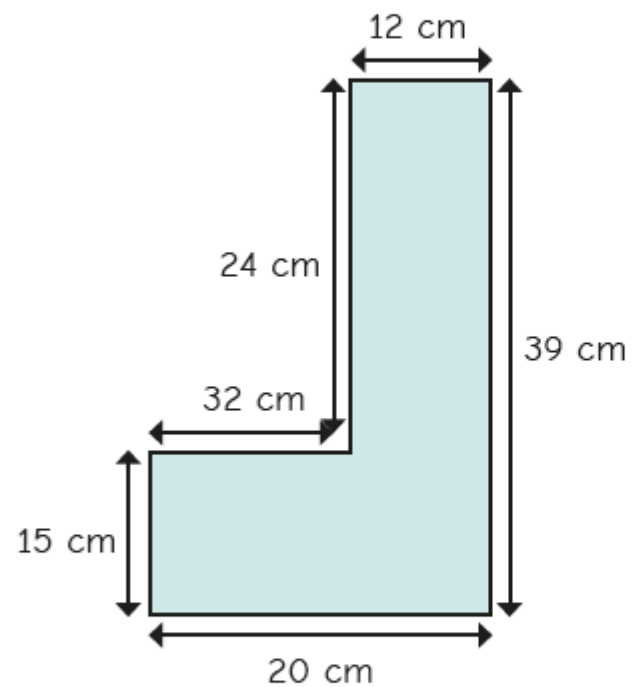
$$\text{Perimeter} = 18\text{cm}$$
