English

As readers and writers, we will be exploring a variety of different texts including those read throughout Reading Practise Sessions. Through each text we will be delving into many different writing skills, from instructions and letter writing to creative writing. We will be using many writing techniques building on our vocabulary and descriptive language. They will continue participating in phonics lessons this year will also see the learning of Phase 5 phonics which introduces alternatives and split vowel diagraphs. There will be an increased focus on the application of high frequency words and the continued use of spelling and reading using phonics taught via Little Wandle.

<u>Science</u>

As scientists we will be focusing on Seasonal Changes. We will look at the four different seasons and techniques to classify them and differences between and when they occur. We will also look at the use of different materials and how they are made.

History & Geography

As Historians we will be looking at our own history and what 'history' is. We will be identifying the use of chronology as a useful skill to locate events in time. We will also look at how special events are celebrated and remembered.

As Geographers we will be looking at the world, having a special deep dive at where we are in the world and a special emphasis on our school and how we can improve it.
