## **English**

As readers and writers, we will be exploring a variety of different texts including those read throughout Reading Practise Sessions. Through each text we will be delving into many different writing skills, from instructions and letter writing to creative writing. We will be using many writing techniques building on our vocabulary and descriptive language. They will continue participating in phonics lessons this year will also see the learning of Phase 5 phonics which introduces alternatives and split vowel diagraphs. There will be an increased focus on the application of high frequency words and the continued use of spelling and reading using phonics taught via Little Wandle.

As Historians we will be looking at the history of toys. We will compare toys from the past to our favourite toys now. We will also be able to identify changes between teddy bears today and those from 100 years ago.

### Science
