

## English

In Reading we will be practising our retrieval skills to answer questions about a text. We will summarise ideas and find evidence to support our answers.

In Writing we will be continuing to write labels, lists and captions and developing our simple sentences. We will look carefully at orally composing and writing sentences. We will also be learning about nouns, verbs, and how important they are in a sentence. We will be writing sets of instructions and beginning to write our own poems/rhymes.

In Phonics we will continue learning Phase 5 sounds and segmenting and blending words for reading and writing. We will be learning to read and write 'tricky words'.

## PSHE (Jigsaw)

We will think carefully about our dreams and goals. We will think about how we can reach these goals. We will also begin to learn about Zones of Regulation and how our emotions and feelings fit into each zone.

## Art and Design

In Art and Design we will explore colour and practise mixing primary colours. We will start to develop understanding of how to use our sketchbooks and look at printing techniques.

## History

We will explore the History of Toys. We will research toys from the past and make comparisons with toys today. We will continue to develop our understanding of how a timeline works and about living memory.

## Maths

In Maths we will look at doubling and halving, odd and even numbers. We will begin sequencing event; learning days of the week and months of the year. We will learn to solve problems. We will begin working with numbers up to 20 for addition and subtraction and will explore equality/balance. We will begin to describe the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes.

## Reading

We will explore parables and engage and explore different bible stories. We will think about what Jesus was trying to tell us about God as we explore different parables.
