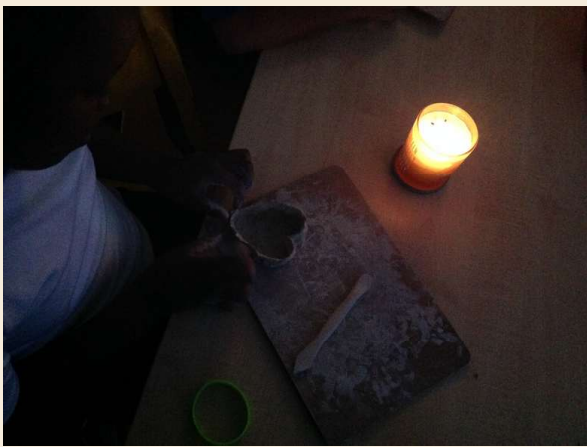
1. How can we measure the world?
